- ◉ **We had in mind the Conference on the History of Particle Physics organized in Paris in July 1982.**
- ◉ **Thanks to the members of the International Scientific Committee (many of them are present today). They contributed efficiently to the program.**
- ◉ **Why now ? We are too old to wait for the 100th anniversary of the Pauli's idea ... and the witnesses are not so young!**
- ◉ **We had fixed a 3-day event and this time constraint made more difficult the preparation of the program, but contacting the potential speakers has been a pleasure since we received very soon a positive answer.**

- ◉ **We apologize in advance: the topic is too broad that all the aspects of the History of the Neutrino will be treated. We just hope not having missed important points.**
- ◉ **Though trying to cover all the facets of this fascinating particle, this conference should be considered as a contribution to the History of the Neutrino, since some chapters are still to be written. There will be place for further such conferences, maybe dedicated to a given topic.**
- ◉ **The objective is, on each topic, to have a historian/historical approach and follow as close as possible the original papers in correlation with the scientific and historical context.**
- ◉ **The equilibrium between science historians and physicists is not as good as wished... but the quality of science historians is very high...**


